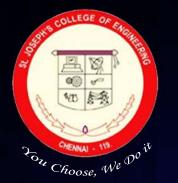

- Last date for receipt of hard copy of registration for participant 25th September 2019.
- Last date for submission of project report 01st October 2019.
- The standard format for the report would be Font Size 12, Heading 14, Times New Roman, 1 Point Spacing, number of pages 3 to 5.
- The project report must consist of
 - o **Title and Theme** (Refer Poster or Brochure for theme)
 - o **Abstract**, not more than 150 words
 - Name of participants and institution/school
 - Novelty or innovativeness of your idea
 - O Clear diagrammatic/ Graphical representation of work flow of the model
 - o Applications And Conclusion drawn from your idea towards the theme topic

Model / Poster Instructions

- The team/ individual may opt to choose a model or a poster
- The model can either be a working or display model
- Clear and proper explanation must be provided during presentation of the model
- Each team can only present either model or poster and not both
- The team/individual are requested to present the poster on a single chart
- The posters are expected to be creative and colorful
- The poster will be judged based of innovativeness of idea, creativity and way of presentation
