- The subject “BS25C01-Physics and Chemistry Laboratory” can be renamed as “Physical Sciences Laboratory” in the 1st Semester.
- The topic “Mathematical Algorithms and Mini project” can be included in the subjects “CS25C01- Problem Solving and Programming in C” & CS25C11- Programming in C Laboratory” in the 1st Semester. Also the course “Problem Solving and Programming in C” can be renamed as “Fundamentals of C”.
- The topics “List ADT, Stack and Queue ADT & Searching technique” can be included in the Subject “CS25C01- Problem Solving and Programming In C” in the 1st Semester instead of CS25C07-Data Structures Using C” in the 2nd Semester.
- The topics “Recent materials : SiC, GaN, etc., and related recent trends ” can be included in the syllabus of the subject “PH25C03-Semiconducting Devices for Modern Electronics” in the 2nd Semester and also the name of the course can be changed.
- Unit 2 and Unit 3 of the subject “PH25C03- Semiconducting Devices for Modern Electronics” is similar to the Unit 4 in the subject “EE25201- Principles of Electrical, Electronics and Communication Engineering” in the 2nd Semester and it has to be modified.
