Minutes

The meeting began with a welcome note from **Dr. Vaddi Seshagiri Rao**, Principal of SJCE and Chairperson of SJCE-IQAC. **Dr. N. Arunkumar**, Coordinator of IQAC, highlighted the role of IQAC and quality initiatives in the departments. This was followed by self-introductions from the committee members.

Dr. N. Arunkumar delivered a brief PowerPoint presentation detailing the status of IQAC and reviewing activities for the academic year 2024-2025. Some of the salient features presented included:

Key Statistics:

- Number of Journal Publications: 313
- Number of Funded Projects: 12 (Total Cost: Rs. 92,12,500)
- Book Chapters and Conference Proceedings: 86
- Patents: 304

Initiatives and Progress for Academic Year 2023-2024:

1. Placements and Higher Studies:

920 students placed and 106 students pursuing higher studies.

2. Promotion of Research and Innovation:

A Centre for Innovation has been developed to promote research and innovation across 21 PEP domains.

3. Incentives for Research Contributions and Publications:

Staff rewards amounting to Rs.23, 52,500 for publications and research projects.

4. Value-added and Certificate Courses:

All departments are offering VACs and certificate courses approved by the BOS.

5. Internal Hackathon:

Four Internal Hackathons were conducted to benefit students by disseminating their skills and innovation.

6. Quiz Event on Quality Standards:

The BIS Club and IEEE chapters conducted a Quiz Event on Quality Standards.

7. AICTE-Idea Lab:

AICTE sanctioned the establishment of a self-sponsored IDEA Lab with an investment of Rs. 1.1 crores.

8. Certified Internship Program for School Students:

Targeting skill development and career awareness among school students.

9. Incubation Centre:

AI incubation and Bridge Green Incubation Centres have been established on campus to foster startup culture.

10. Increase in PEP Centres:

Recent PEP domains such as Digital Manufacturing and Power BI have been proposed.

11. Cash Rewards for Students:

Rs. 1.05 Crore (Merit Scholarship) and Rs.15.2 lakh awarded for academic performance, paper and patent publications, competition winners, NPTEL certifications, and recognitions.

12. International Conference:

The 2nd International Conference on Technological Advancements in Materials, Design, Manufacturing and Energy Sectors (ICTAMDMES 2024) was organized on 21st and 22nd August 2024.

13. Industry Conclave:

Industry Academia Networking Conclave (IANC 2025) was organized on 21st March 2025, Industry and academia persons were invited to share knowledge, experience, technology, science and collaboration opportunities.

Academic Council Meetings:

The Academic Council meeting was held on December 18, 2024,

Department BOS Meeting:

The Department BOS meeting was conducted to update and modify the syllabus, including employability courses and value-added courses for students enrolling from the year 2024.

NIRF Ranking:

Our institution participated in the NIRF ranking(Engineering, Innovation and SDG) for 2024.

Grant Achievements:

Our students from the departments of ECE, Biotech, and Mechanical received a total of Rs. 31.5 lakhs for Business Model Development in the National Level Grant Challenge MSME IDEA HACKATHON (WOMEN) 3.0 - 2023, organized by MSME, Government of India.

Mechanical Team Achievement:

The Mechanical Students Team, named "Aurelian Racing Team 6.0," constructed an All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) and participated in SAE m-BAJA 2025, conducted by NATRIP in Madhya Pradesh in January 2025. The team also participated in ATVC Event and bagged 5 trophies in various events. The Team also participated SAEINDIA is an affiliate society of SAE International, registered as a non-profit engineering and scientific society dedicated to the advancement of the mobility community in India.

Open Discussion:

Following the presentation, an open discussion was held.

- Organizing recent advancement-oriented workshops and internships for students.
- Satisfactory student participation in competitions such as Hackathon, Ideathon, IICDC, and Toycathon.
- Feedback from stakeholders will be instrumental in improving the teaching-learning process.

Decisions Taken:

- Strengthen **Industry-Institute Interaction** through signing MOUs, arranging more industrial visits, guest lectures, and industrial exposure training from industry professionals.
- Enhance student chapter activities through participation in upcoming national technical events like E-BAJA, M-BAJA, Go-kart racing under SAE, Technology Dissemination Contest under IEEE, and competitions under the OSA chapter.
- Aim for a higher number of **patents and copyrights** awarded to faculty members in forthcoming academic years.

Targets for Academic Year 2025-2026:

- Encourage student participation in technical and innovative contests and competitions.
- Arrange international seminars, workshops, conferences, and FDPs across all departments.
- Increase collaborative projects with industries and secure government-funded projects.
- Enhance journal publications with a higher impact factor.
