Students' Feedback on Curriculum

Academic year 2020-21, got impacted in education and preparation for industry due to the COVID 19 lockdown and classes being carried out online. As a part of it, college has obtained feedback on curriculum from students through questionnaire which contain the following five major aspects such as Course content & Organisation, Interactive participation, Learning environment & teaching methods, Learning resource and Quality of delivery and assessment. Totally 163 students gave their feedback on curriculum for the academic year 2020-2021. About 98% of the students marked that the course content and organisation was appropriate to the UG programme. About 70% expressed their views on interactive participation to be less excellency due to the less face to face interaction time during lockdown however, 30% felt excellent and very good means of interaction. Around 96% students voted more than good in teaching environment and methods due to the creative Presentation tools of lectures in Google meet, animations, audio and video-based teaching approaches but about 4% felt just less than good due to the noisy environment at homes while listening to the lectures. Google classroom, Online portal with open lectures, study resources and online book banks played a key role in the education of students which reflected in the 97% votes. The feedback revealed that 97% of the students have strong agreement about the quality of delivery and the internal assessment for the specified programme.

Feedback analysis report

Overall Analysis of the feedback reflected the satisfaction of majority of students in the areas of course content and organisation, learning resources and quality delivery. Interactive participation of students with teachers and learning environment scored reduced satisfaction due to the disturbances and constraints in online mode of learning. Students felt the lack of the extra-curricular activities & usage of library due to the online mode.

Action Taken

Students and teacher's interactive participation were improved through practical exposure of students to the concepts through interactive enhancing web tools such as menti, Whatsapp groups etc. To improve interactive participation quiz, questions boxes, group discussions on concepts and Q&A sessions during class hours were encouraged. E-library resources were shared. Online events for school students were organized by the students as a part of extra-curricular activity.

TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

- From the feedback on the curriculum collected from teachers most of the parameters are between excellent and very good criteria.
- Certain parameters like industry needs, practicality of the courses and the laboratory classes, curriculum based on need fall under less than excellent criteria due to the unavailability of practical classes in hands on practice way due to the online education changes during lockdown as well as due to the unavailability of inplant training due to the pandemic situations and lockdown.
- Actions were taken to enhance those short falls in the subjects based on the ideas from teachers and experts.
- Need of Extra hours for Civil software laboratory was considered.
- Value added courses and Online Guest lectures have to be conducted to rectify these needs of filling industry-institution gap.
- MOU's with industries and R&D collaborations are needed to improve the curriculum and make the students knowledgeable.
- Enrolment in various online courses and attending inplant trainings in nearby construction sites to the students following COVID protocol has to be encouraged.

ACTION TAKEN:

- Online guest lectures, online training programs, webinars from alumni from industries were arranged to bridge the shortfall that was experienced.
- Software based modelling and projects were encouraged during this year.
