## YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR

**Mr.J.Noorulameen** of **Final year student** was sanctioned a loan **Rupees 9 Lakhs** under **Prime minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP)** for his business plan, **Coconut husk brick**. A brick is building material used to make walls, pavements and other elements in masonry construction. A brick can be composed of clay-bearing soil, sand, and lime, or concrete materials. Two basic categories of bricks are fired and non-fired bricks. Brick is a similar term referring to a rectangular building unit composed of similar materials, but is usually larger than a brick. His study mainly focuses on usage of coconut fibre in clay brick, which will reduce the cost and weight. The coconut fibre of different proportions is added to the bricks and tests were conducted to study the property of fibre added brick. Coconut husk has the capacity to keep moisture inside which help to grow plant healthier. He is going to produce coconut husk in the shape of rectangular bricks.
