The college has incessantly bagged **the highest number of University Ranks** with an ostentatious total of **53 ranks with 3 Gold and 6 Silver medals in popular branches** for the 14<sup>th</sup> consecutive year in Anna University Examinations held in May 2019.

All the Rank holders were appreciated and applauded by Cash Prizes, a substantial total worth **Rs.14 lakhs** which includes **Rs. 50,000/-** each for the **Gold Medal**, **Rs.25, 000/-** each for all other Rank Holders and shields.
