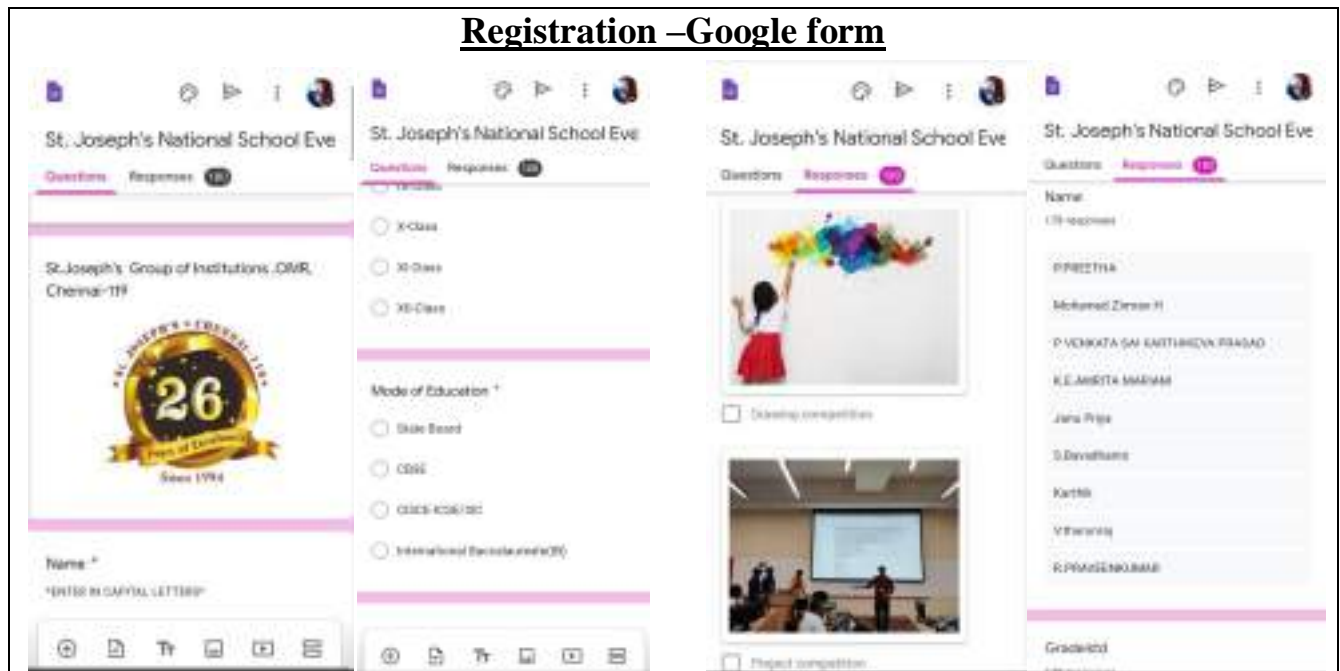

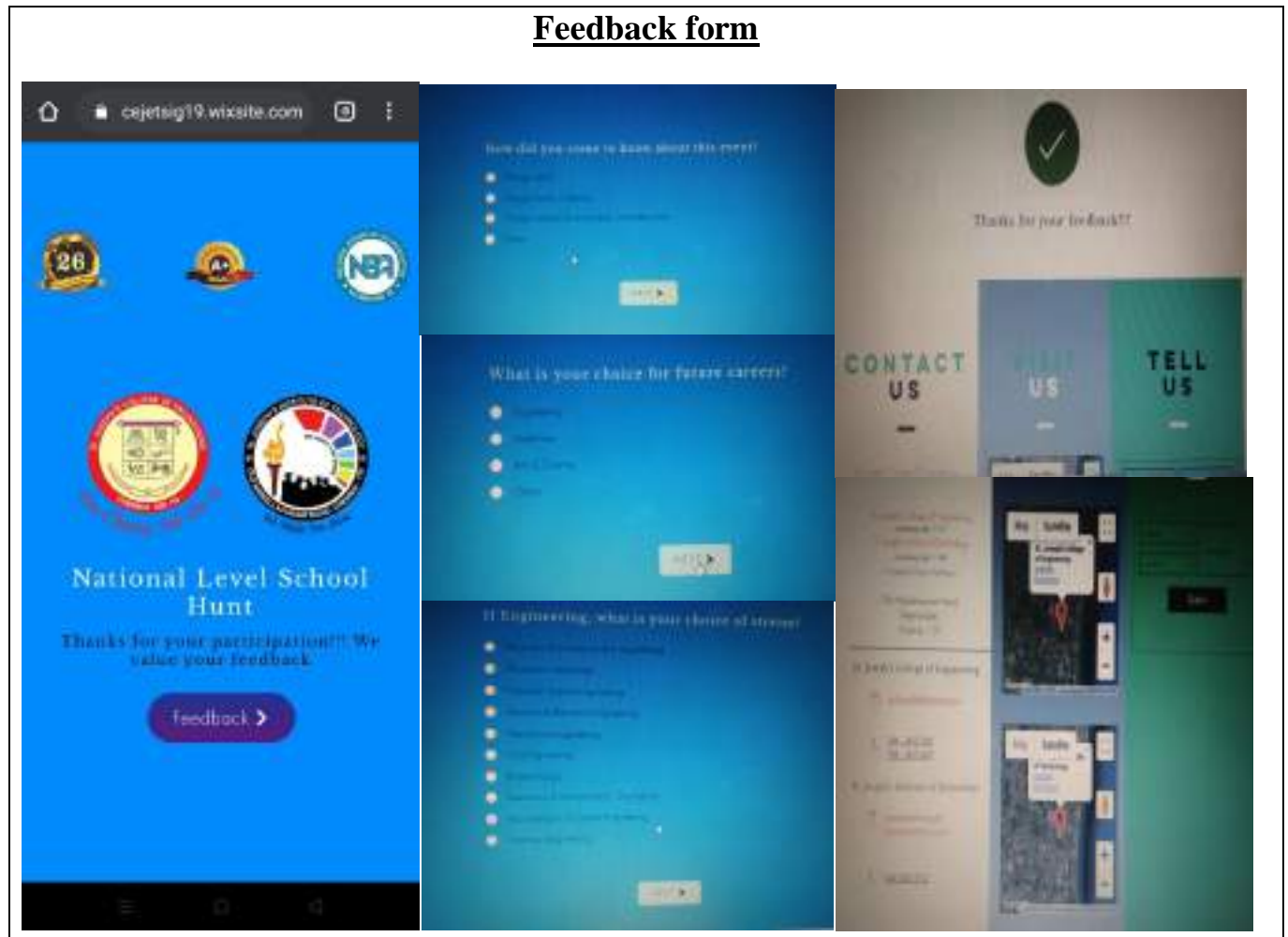

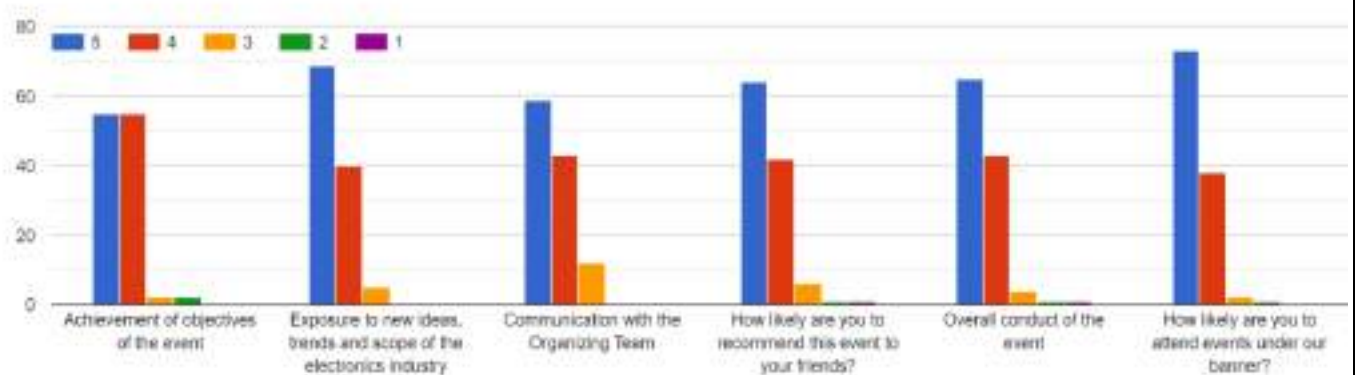
REPORT
