
Report on Online alumni mentoring session


#### **REPORT**


This alumni webinar drew participants from various other colleges besides and St. students from Joseph's Group of Institutions. A total of 75 participants got benefitted out of this webinar.






- Introduction to AI, Machine and Deep Learning
