

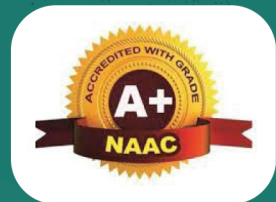

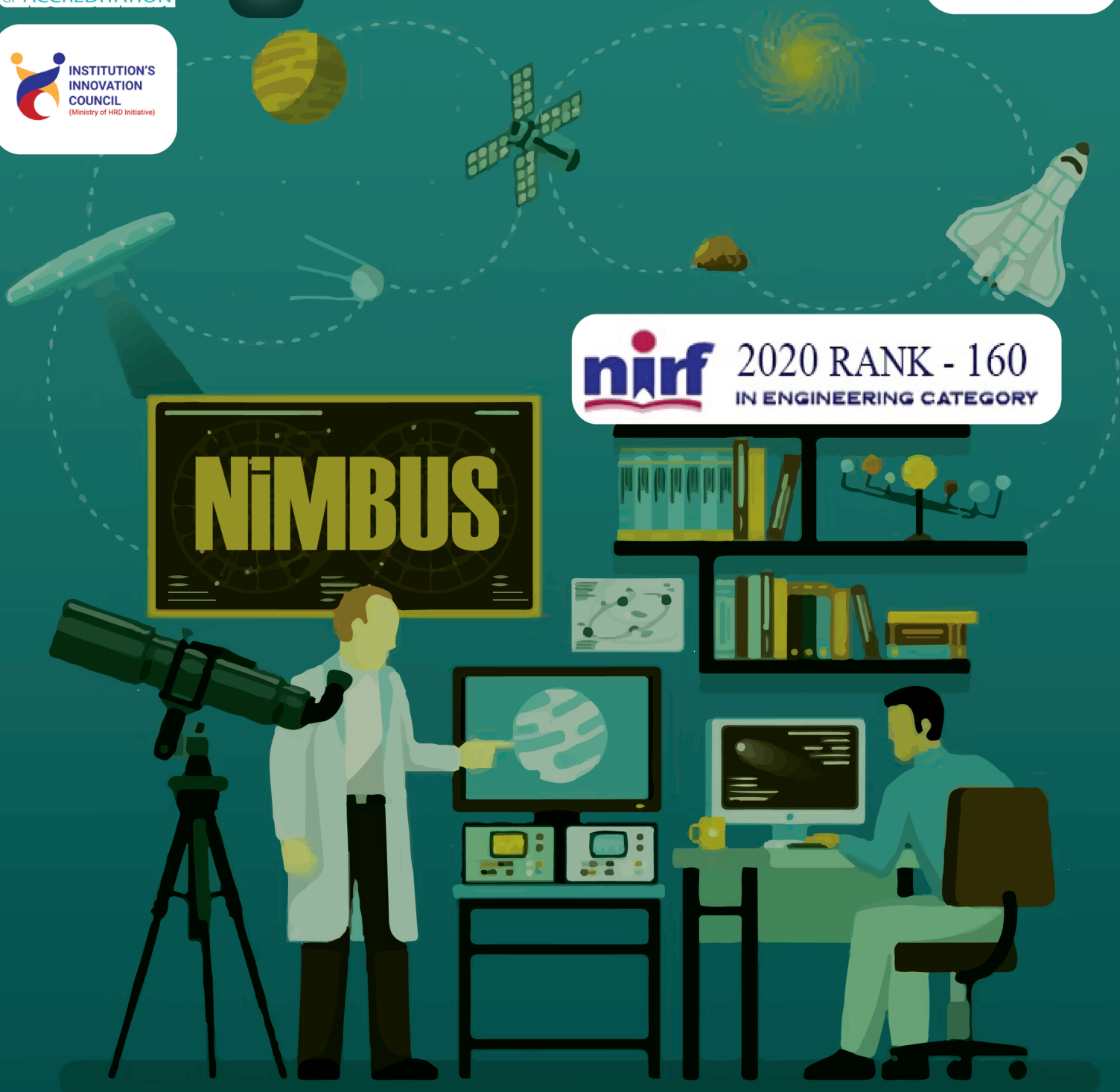

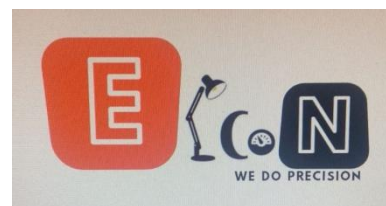

More than 1000 aspiring students attended the inaugural ceremony and interacted with the chief guest.

On 04.09.2019, we have **conducted a screening test for Defence Aspirants**, in view of starting classes for the deserving students. The screening test was conducted to check the ability of students in the following three different categories like verbal ability, general aptitude and general awareness. **Around 800 students were actively participated in the screening test.**

- Understand some advanced features of C++ including templates, exceptions, and multiple inheritance.
