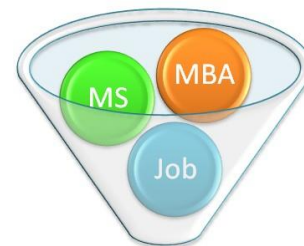

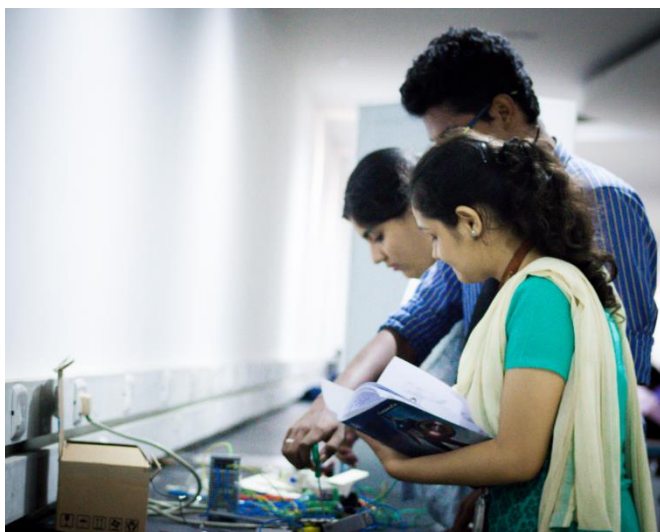
Third Year:
